Domestic Abuse in The Work Place

Domestic abuse costs society an estimated £15.73 billion a year in terms of costs to services, economic output, human and emotional costs. (Walby, 2009)

UK business lose £316 million in economic output each year as result of work absences related to domestic abuse (Vodafone UK News Centre 2019) with as many as one in five victims taking time off work because of abuse (TUC, 2014).

More than 1/4 of women and more than 1/6 of men in Northamptonshire have experienced domestic abuse during their lifetime.

75% of women that experience domestic abuse are targeted whilst they are at work.

This could include:

- Staff receiving harassing phone calls
- Abusive partners arriving at their work place unannounced
- Physical assaults
- Stalking

Based on national statistics, 45,000 people (6% of the county's population) were victims of domestic abuse during the last 12 months. Of that figure, around 38,000 people (85%) sought help at least 5 times before getting the correct help they needed.

With one third of a working adult's life spent in work, employers are in a unique position to create a supportive workplace culture that encourages the identification of health and wellbeing needs and to help break the silence around this issue.



Group work

Our children's groups focus on healthy relationships, child to parent abuse and supporting a child with what they have been through. We offer female, and male only groups for survivors, and In partnership with Creating Equalz, we offer group work specifically for black and brown female victims of domestic abuse.

Outreach

The outreach support offered to adult clients is available to victims of current or historical abuse. We provide person centred weekly support in the community, either in homes or in a safe space.

Refuge

The refuge accommodation we provide includes provision for men and women, (and their children) women with substance misuse issues, women from black and minority ethnic communities and disabled clients. We run 9 units throughout Northamptonshire.

Drop In Services

We offer drop in support services in: Kettering, Corby, Wellingborough, Towcester, Raunds, Northampton and Rushden. We also offer VIRTUAL appointments Mondays and Thursdays 1pm - 3pm via: www.ndas.co/i-need-help

Professional Training
